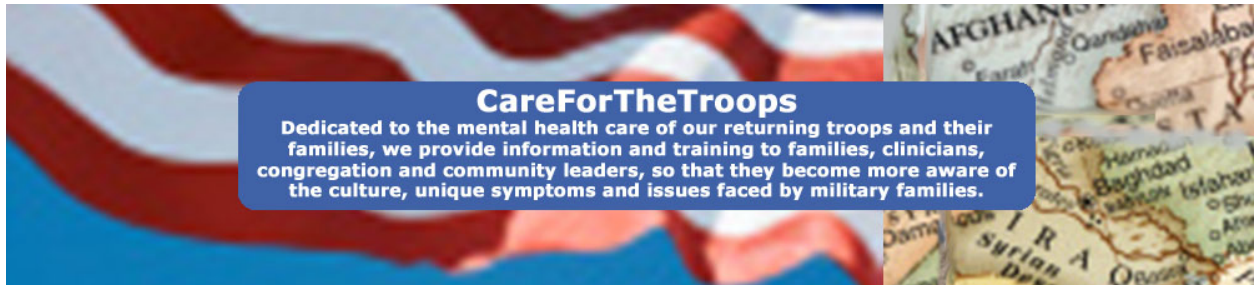

 - Applying generally accepted accounting principles;
 - Reporting the financial position and operations of the organization on a timely basis in a consistent, clear, concise manner; and
 - Complying with all relevant regulatory requirements necessary to maintain tax-exempt status.
2. The interests of donors will be respected. We will do this by:
 - Issuing timely and accurate receipts for donations;
 - Maintaining proper records of donor-imposed restrictions on funds; and
 - Disbursing restricted funds in compliance with the letter and spirit of the restrictions.
