- ❑ The AR-WFAC connects Soldiers, Families, and Retirees to available benefits and entitlements.

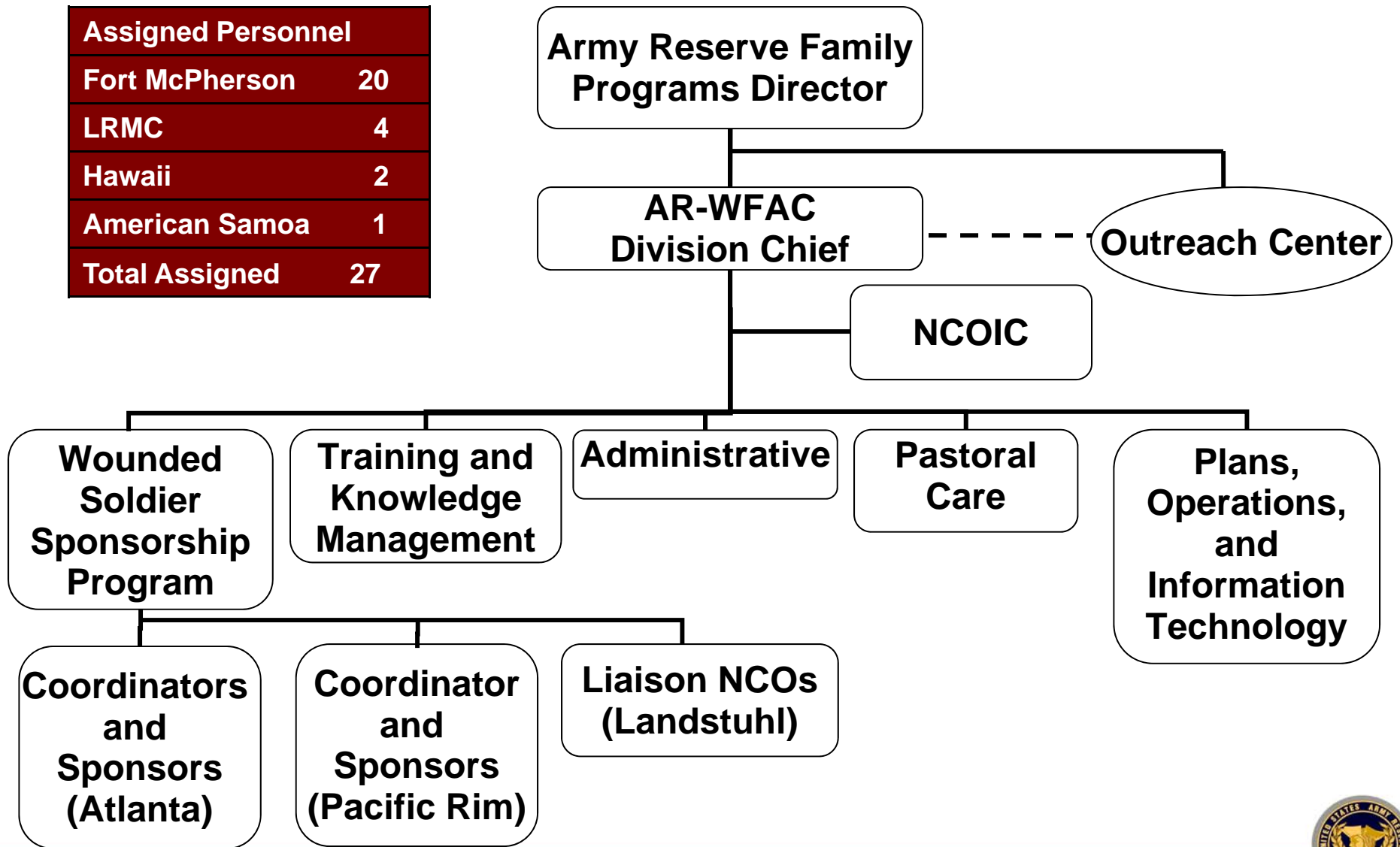


- ❑ Established 10 October 2007

 - ✓ Pacific Rim

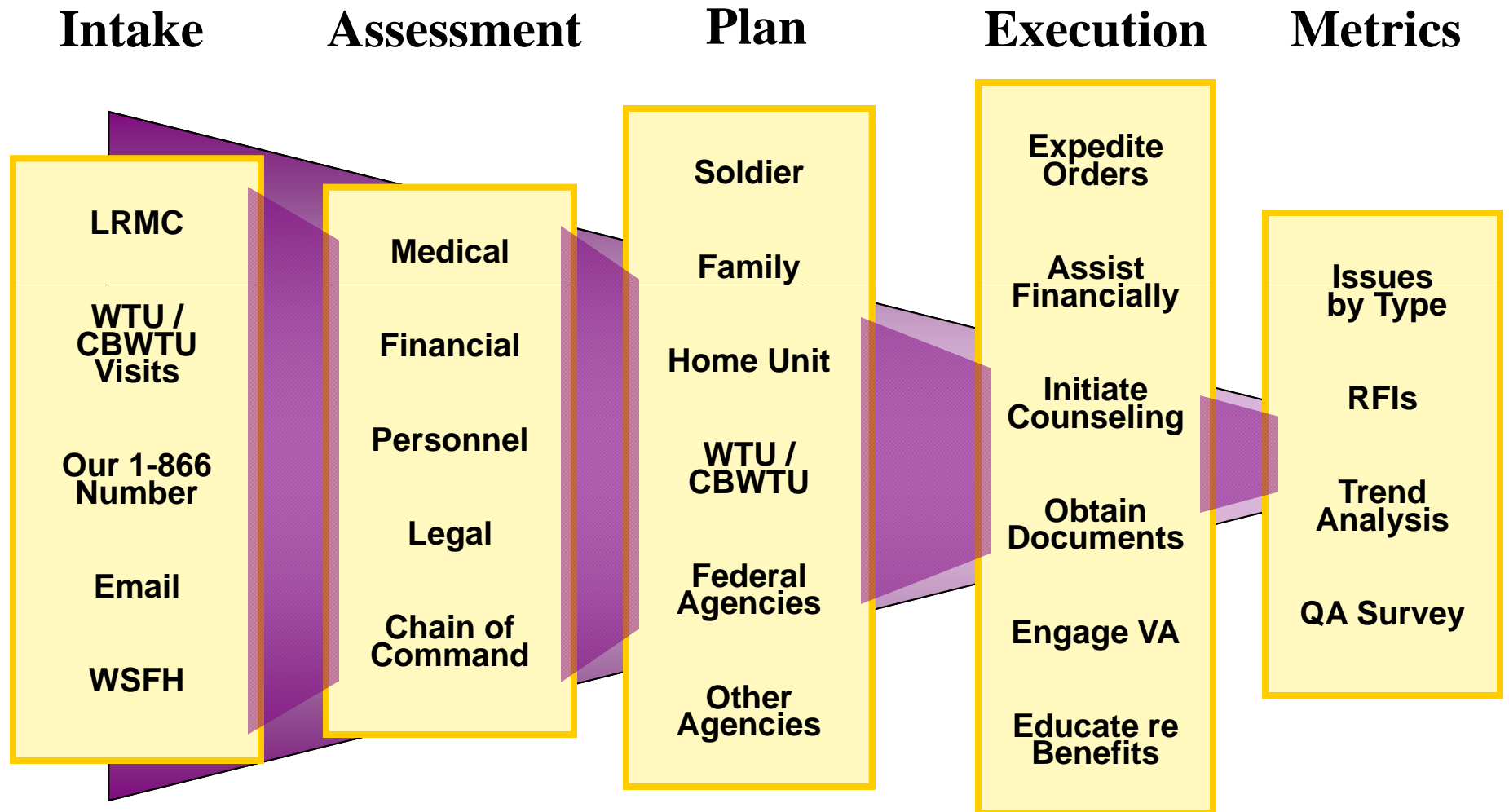


Organizational Structure

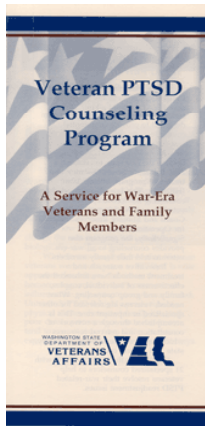

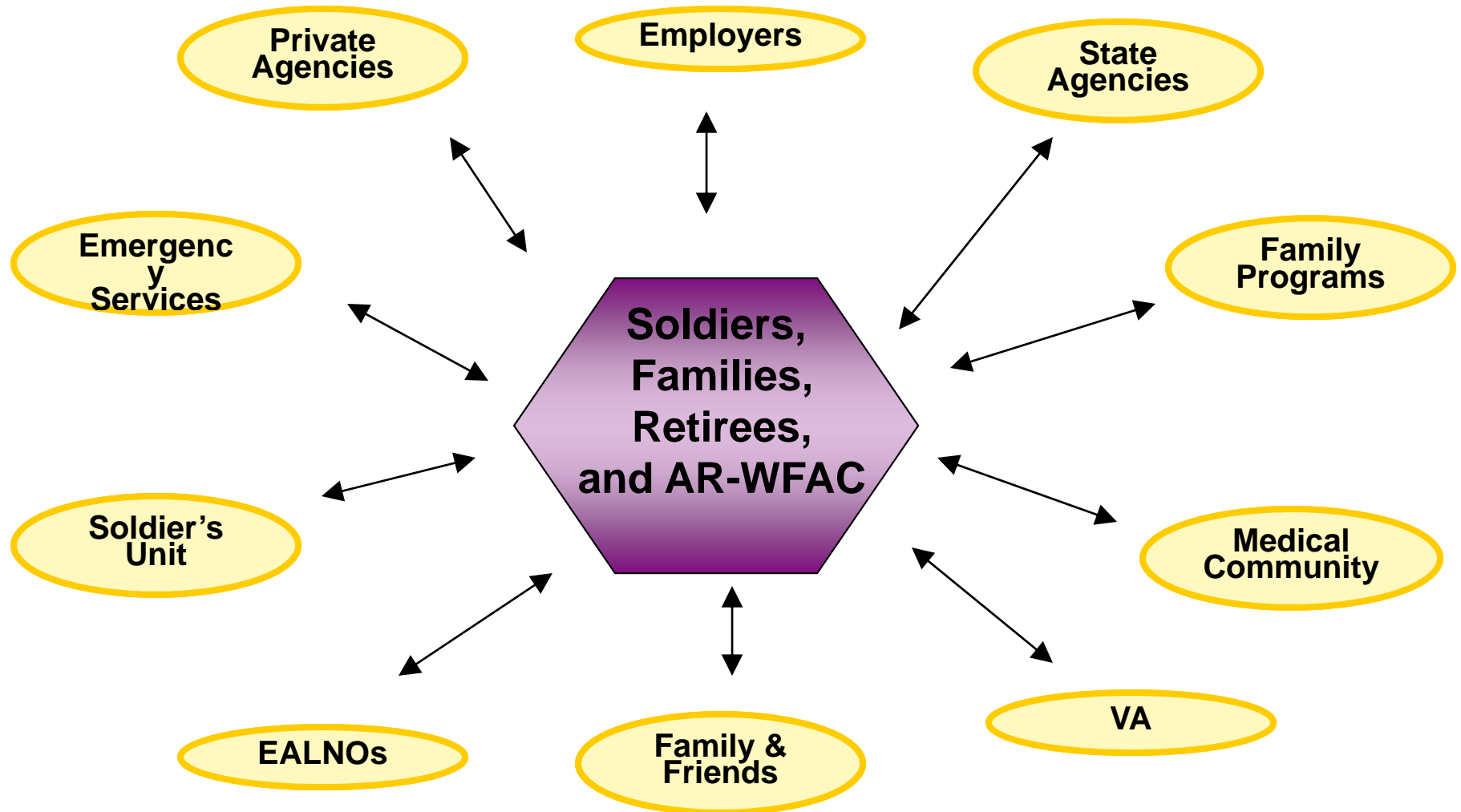

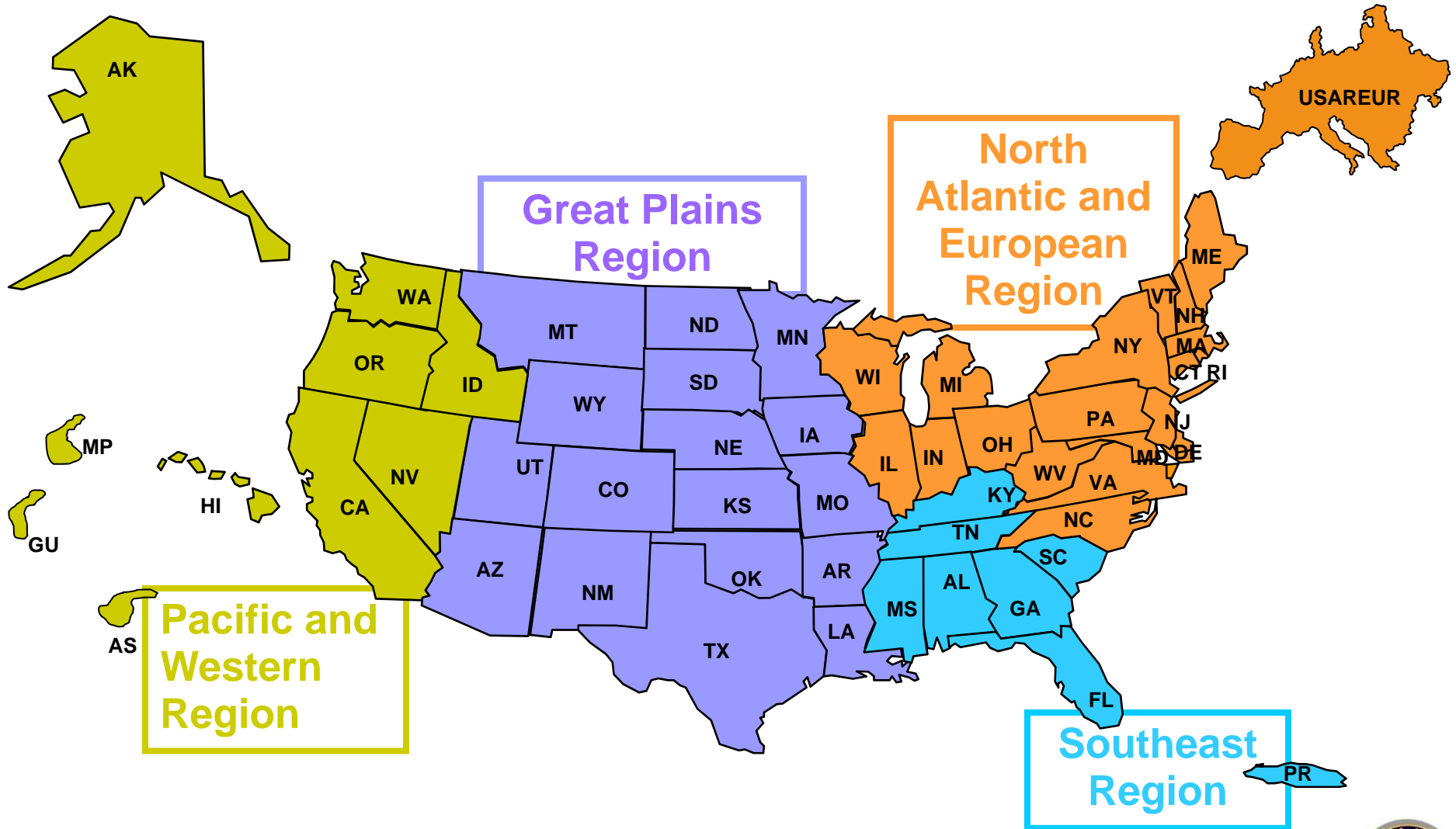

Duties and Responsibilities of the EALNO

□ The EALNO

- ✓ Is a local extension of the AR-WFAC.
- ✓ Educates, enhances and augments their Chain of Command regarding existing benefits available to the Soldier, their Families and Retirees.
- ✓ Serve as an advocate for the Soldier, Family and Retiree.
- ✓ Provides direct assistance to their Command by educating their Soldiers about the available services that are designed to address issues that are important to them.
- ✓ Is not a subject matter expert. However, he/she will partner with the Command, Soldiers, Family Members, and Retirees to resolve issues.

 - ✓ Updates Army Reserve Commanders at Battle-Focused Readiness Reviews (BFRRs) in CONUS and OCONUS
